- 3.2) Any changes to this Memorandum must be made in writing and signed by the Parties.


4) GENERAL OBLIGATIONS









5) CONFIDENTIALITY


- 5.1) The Parties each hereby acknowledge and agree that in connection with this Memorandum, they may have access to information that is confidential and/or commercially valuable to one or more of the other Parties ("Confidential Information").
- The Parties each hereby acknowledge and agree that they may be both the receiving 5.2)party in relation to some Confidential Information ("Receiving Party"), and the disclosing party in relation to some other Confidential Information ("Disclosing Party") and that the terms of this Memorandum may apply to a Party as both a Receiving Party and as a Disclosing Party, as the context so provides.
- For the purpose of this Memorandum, Confidential Information may include but is not 5.3) limited to:
 - a) information of whatever nature relating to the Project or to another Party (whether relating to the Project or otherwise);
 - b) any information derived from any other information which falls within this definition of Confidential Information; and
 - c) any copy of any Confidential Information. but does not include information which:
 - was known or in possession of the Receiving Party before it was provided to the i. Receiving Party by the Disclosing Party, provided that it was known or in the possession of the Receiving Party through legal means, and not as a result of any breach of this Memorandum or any other agreement or obligation relating to confidentiality (whether or not the Receiving Party was a Party to such other agreement or obligation);
 - is, or becomes, publicly available, through no fault of the Receiving Party; ii.
 - is provided to the Receiving Party without restriction or disclosure by a third iii. not breach any confidentiality obligations by making such a party, who did disclosure;
 - is provided to the Receiving Party by the Disclosing Party and is marked "Non iv. Confidential", or

- v. is required by law or regulation to be disclosed, but in the event that this exception applies, it applies only to the absolute minimum necessary and provided that the Disclosing Party is first consulted to establish whether and if so how far it is possible to prevent or restrict such enforced disclosure.
- d) In relation to any Confidential Information:
 - the Receiving Party shall keep the Confidential Information confidential and secret.
 - ii. The Receiving Party shall only use the Confidential Information for the purpose of working in good faith on the Project in accordance with this Memorandum.
 - iii. The receiving Party shall not release the Confidential Information to any other party, unless that other party is an advisor who is under a duty of confidentiality, is assisting with the Project, and needs to have the Confidential Information in order to assist with the Project.
- e) If there is any doubt as to whether any particular information constitutes Confidential Information, the receiving party should presume it is Confidential Information, until the receiving party obtains explicit confirmation from the Disclosing party that it is not Confidential Information.
- f) Each Party's respective obligations of confidentiality under this clause will survive the termination or expiration of this Memorandum and will continue after that Party ceases to participate in the Project.

6) TIMING AND DURATION OF PROJECT

- 6.1) This Memorandum will commence on the date of the signing of this MoU.
- 6.2) This Memorandum will remain in effect until the completion of the project, or unless and until otherwise terminated by the Parties.
- 6.3) The Parties may terminate this Memorandum by mutual agreement.
- 6.4) Either Party may terminate this Memorandum by providing 1 month notice in writing to the other Party.



 - In the event that a Party ("Receiving Party") is in possession of any equipment, materials, documents, intellectual property, data or other information ("Items") that are the property of the other Party ("Disclosing Party"), then the Receiving Party must promptly return all items to the Disclosing Party, or destroy any Items if directed to do so by the Disclosing Party; and


8) COSTS


Unless otherwise expressly provided in writing, each Party is responsible for its own costs of complying with this Memorandum and in connection with the performance of its obligations under this Memorandum.

9) FORCE MAJEURE

If and to the extent that a Party's performance of any of its obligations under this MoU, hindered or delayed by fire, flood, earthquake, elements of nature or acts of God, Pandemic, acts of war, terrorism, riots, civil disorders, rebellions or revolutions, or any other similar cause beyond the reasonable control of such Party (each, a "Force Majeure Event"), and such non performance, hindrance or delay could not have been prevented by reasonable precautions, then the non-performing, hindered or delayed Party will be excused for such non-performance, hindrance or delay, as applicable, of those obligations effected by the Force Majeure Event for as long as such Force Majeure Event continues and such Party continues to use its best efforts to recommence performance whenever and to whatever extent possible without delay, including through the use of alternate sources, workaround plans or other means. The Party whose performance is prevented,





hindered or delayed by a Force Majeure Event will immediately notify the other Parties of the occurrence of the Force Majeure Event and describe in reasonable detail the nature of the Force Majeure Event.

If the Force Majeure Event continues for a continuous period exceeding 30 (thirty) days, the Parties shall mutually agree on the future course of action. However, despite all efforts made by the Parties in good faith, if the Force Majeure Event continues for a period of 90 (ninety) days, either of the Parties shall have the right to terminate this MoU by giving the other Parties notice of termination on writing.

10) INDEMNITY

Each Party ("Indemnifying Party") hereby agrees to indemnify and hold the other Party harmless from all the damages, costs, attorney's fees or other losses arising out of or relating to:

- a) breach of this MoU by the Indemnifying Party;
- b) breach of any representation or warranty by the Indemnifying Party.

11) SEVEREBILITY

If any provision of this MoU shall for any reason be held to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable in any respect, such invalidity, illegality, or unenforceability shall not affect any other provision thereof, and this MoU shall be construed as if such invalid, illegal or unenforceable provision had never been contained herein. Any invalid or unenforceable provision of this MoU shall be replaced with a provision that is valid and enforceable and most nearly gives effect to the original intent of the invalid/unenforceable provision


12) ENTIRE AGREEMENT


