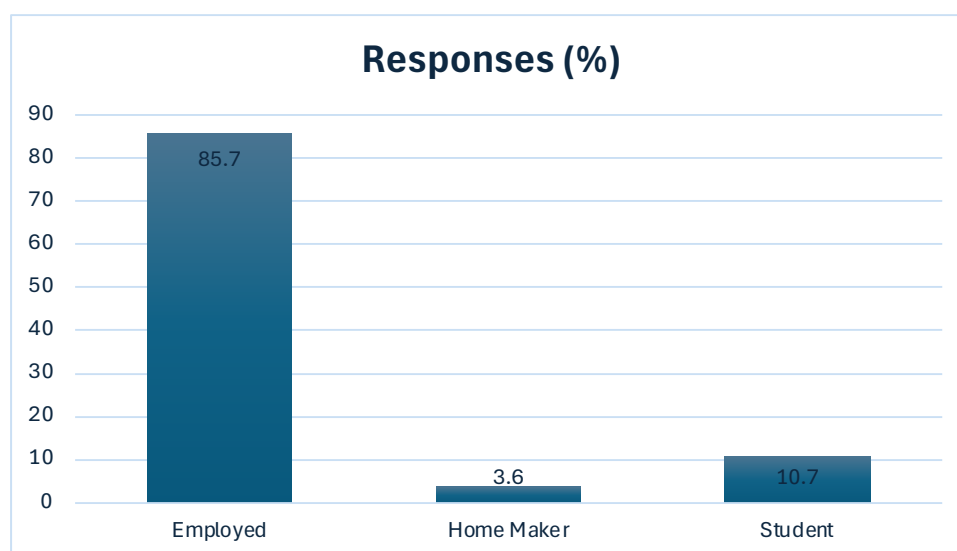

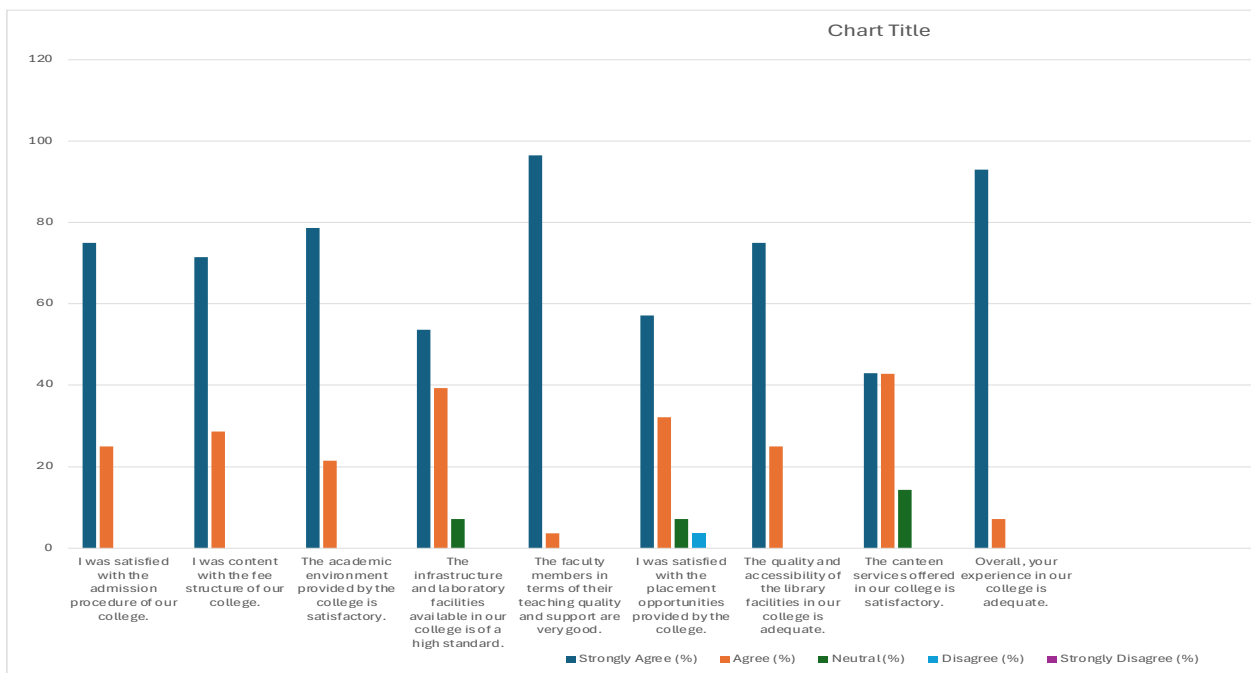

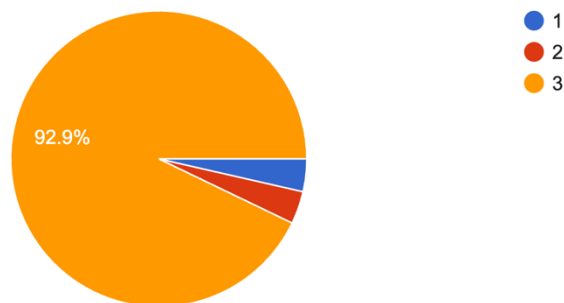

Rate the Alumni Meet



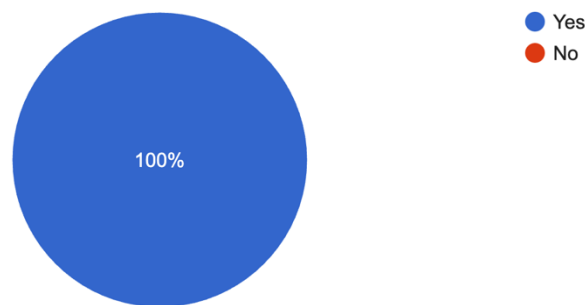

Do you feel proud to be associated with VKM as Alumni?



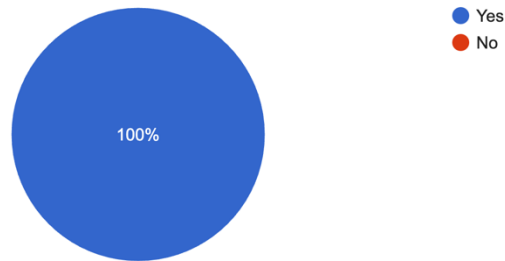
